To ensure your success in this ensemble, and furthered success of the ensemble as a whole, we have put together a brief set of policies and procedures for you to abide by. The rules and policies are set forth in this packet to assist us in developing the best program possible for musical and athletic achievement. This also serves as a Q & A for parents regarding what is expected of everyone. Remember that we have a short amount of time to put together a lot of music, and that you have been selected because you have demonstrated to your director the ability to abide by these rules.

Every rehearsal will also serve as a *continuing audition* for this ensemble. Students who do not demonstrate the necessary attitude, dedication, and rehearsal etiquette will be evaluated and further involvement in the ensemble is based on this. You may be asked not to return if the following cannot be adhered to. If you abide by the rules and policies below, you maximize your own experience, and ensure your continued success not only within the ensemble, but in all other areas of your life!

#### 1.) Arrive ON TIME!

Because we have such a limited amount of time, every second of rehearsal is valuable. Neither the instructors, nor the other members of the ensemble, can afford to wait on you to arrive to rehearsal. Excessive tardiness will not be tolerated and is dependent on the student's continued audition.

#### 2.) All Rehearsals and Performances are 100% mandatory!

You must be in attendance at every rehearsal. The *only* exceptions that can be made are death in the immediate family, and serious illness. If there is a schedule conflict with your home band program, please tell your director to contact Mr. Graham, Mrs. Graham, or Mr. Whitehead to explain the situation. Constant absences will not be tolerated and may result in the loss of your position.

## 3.) Practicing your music outside of rehearsal is MANDATORY!

We have very limited time to review notes and rhythms. Most of rehearsal will be spent going over "big picture" things like balance, dynamics, and musical style. It is imperative that you are already familiar with your part before rehearsal. As a marching ensemble, we also have to *memorize* all of our music. Practice outside of rehearsal is imperative.

## 4.) All Performances are 100% mandatory!

The only exceptions are listed above.

Please find attached three important forms that need to be completed and signed by both the student and the student's parent/guardian. Attached is also a rehearsal schedule, along with our performance dates. Please mark these dates in your calendars. Transportation to these rehearsals will be the responsibility of the student and/or the student's parent/guardian. Transportation to and from performances may be provided by the district. Please read the following forms carefully and return these to the directors of the SCCPSS Honor Marching Band by the **second** rehearsal.
